Useful Imperial to Metric Conversions:

 $1 inch \approx 2.5 cm$   $1 foot \approx 30 cm = 0.3 m$   $1 mile \approx 1.6 km$ 

To convert inches to centimetres, multiply by 2.5. To convert centimetres to inches, divide by 2.5.

The London Eye is **440 feet** high.


using 1 foot  $\approx$  30 cm: 440  $\times$  30 = 13200 cm = 132 m


